OBJECTIVES

- to organize interactive legal language seminars in English and German;
- to focus on legal terminology of general EU law and on specific areas giving the possibility for practitioners to be able to understand EU institutions, EU legal instruments, EU legal acts and forms and texts related to EU law in the field of judicial cooperation in criminal, civil and commercial matters;
- to produce training materials that can be used for legal language training, both for presence and blended learning;
- to form a network of legal language trainers and experts that will share best training practices and methods.

 - 3 coordination meetings for the purposes of setting standards for the implementation, monitoring and evaluation of legal language seminars and conference;

 - 1 conference for trainers and experts to enable sharing of best practices and methods, analyzing future training needs and setting standards in the area of legal language training;
- development of training materials in formats enabling their use for presence learning and blended learning;
- setting standards for legal language training for the future.
